- 1. Call to Order: Jamie Lynn Haskins called the meeting to order at 1:06 p.m.
- 2. Faculty & Staff Symposium: Elizabeth Outka and Lidia Radi presented on the first faculty and staff research symposium. It is meant to be an annual, one-day research symposium held in the fall semester and serves as a rough parallel to UR's A&S undergraduate research symposium. It would bring faculty and staff together to present on their current work through interdisciplinary panels, roundtables, short-format sessions, and posters. Participants might discuss elements of a current book project or article; a program, initiative, or partnership; an artwork or performance; a current line of research experiments; an archive or digital project; a musical composition or a piece of creative writing; an experience in leadership or strategy, etc. It is hosted by A&S, the symposium would include faculty and staff from all five schools.

It hopes to allow us to learn what people are doing across campus, exchange ideas, and connect with others. Helps foster a community of scholars on campus. Requires minimal time and labor—all in one day on work participants are already doing. Creates interdisciplinary connections that might spark new collaborative projects, classes, and partnerships.

Held in Boatwright Library on Friday, September 22. Will include a lunch gathering and an afternoon reception. Faculty and staff from across campus are invited to participate and/or attend.
